Make a Hygiene Kit for Disaster Relief

In the face of natural disasters, such as the devastating tornados that swept through the South, or the floods along the Missouri and Mississippi, Hygiene Kits can mean the difference between sickness and health for struggling families.

A Mission Ministry Team was formed to assemble and ship Hygiene Kits to the UCC Church World Service Organization. We need your help!

There are two ways you can help...

To assemble a Hygiene Kit you will need:

- One hand towel measuring approximately 16" x 28" (no fingertip or bath towels)
- One washcloth
- One wide-tooth comb
- One nail clipper
- One bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- One toothbrush (in original packaging)
- Six standard size Band-Aids®

Place all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with a zipper closure; remove excess air from bag, and seal. Please do not add toothpaste to the Hygiene Kit. Cartons of toothpaste that have an extended expiration date will be added to Hygiene Kit shipments just prior to shipment.

If you would rather make a cash contribution the value of a Hygiene kit is estimated to be \$12. Make your check out to St. Peter's UCC and in the memo line write "Hygiene Kit".

Your Ministry Team will assemble the kits and ship to the UCC World Service Organization. We would anticipate shipment the first week in August, so please act quickly. If you have questions, please call the Caudy's at 630.530.0073
