Taizé Worship

Taizé worship is a unique style of worship that has become popular in churches, retreat centers, and seminaries throughout the world. The singing of distinctive and much-repeated prayer refrains during candlelit prayer services is one of its trademarks. Taizé music highlights simple phrases, usually lines from the Psalms or other pieces of scripture. The repetition of music is designed to help meditation and prayer. Worship includes a rather long period of silent meditation as well as intercessory prayers for individuals, the church, and the world. The style of worship is highly meditative and brings many individuals closer to God.
